By clicking on the [Programs](#) button located in the navigation bar on the left, you are able to search for programs based on a number of criteria such as term, location and major areas of study.

When looking at a program brochure page, you will be able to see important program information and either 'Request Advising' or 'Apply Now'. When you request advising you will be asked to complete a Pre-Advising Questionnaire and you can also set an appointment with the Study Abroad Advisor. When you click Apply Now you will be directed to the UNH Application to Study Abroad.
